GENERAL TIPS ON HOW TO KEEP VINYL ROOF FABRIC BEAUTIFUL AND LONG LASTING:

Do keep your roof clean. This is the best protection against mildew. Even on mildew resistant fabric, mildew can grow on accumulated dirt or foreign bottom surface and eventually damage or stain the fabric. We cannot be responsible for such damage.

Do wash down your roof; brushing lightly with a cloth or soft brush. You can use a mild soap, but rinse thoroughly and immediately.

Do hose you roof down occasionally every month or so with a garden hose. We recommend you do this on a hot sunny day.

Do keep the underside of your roof clean by simply brushing with a clean household broom. It may also be washed on the underside in the same manner as the top. Mildew will not attach to a clean awing.

Do not fold or roll in extreme cold temperatures.

Do not drag your roof across any abrasive surfaces, such as a cement drive.

Do not get insect spray on the vinyl fabric, as some solutions may cause staining or discolor.

Do not allow water to stand on the roof, causing pocketing and possible stretching.

Do not overlook small rips or tears. If a sharp object punctures the fabric, it can be expertly repaired by your local fabricator.

Do not wash your roof with a harsh or strong solution, or scrub too vigorously with an abrasive cleaner.

Do not force or yank your roof when raising or lowering them, do it gradually.

Do not use a charcoal grill underneath the roof.

Do not store roof when damp or wet. Mildew is fabric's greatest foe and is caused by dampness. Mildew may grow on the surface of a damp roof and permanently stain the fabric.

Do not permit leaves, twigs, ect. to remain on your roof as they might cause staining of the fabric.
